**Memorandum of Agreement

- Requires a pool of well prepared youth to begin careers in shipbuilding and repair, and

Whereas the State of Alaska through the Alaska Industrial Development and Export Authority (AIDEA) supports the concurrent development of the Ketchikan Shipyard to complete construction of essential shipyard infrastructure to maximize employment opportunities in the state in Advanced Manufacturing and shipbuilding and repair in the State;

Therefore be it resolved, that the KGBSD and AISD will collaborate on expanding CTE resources for youth in Annette Islands School District for career opportunities in shipbuilding and repair and related marine, industrial, and manufacturing careers in Ketchikan and the State through

- Development of an effective school to work, school to apprentice program, and
