

Ketchikan Shipyard Improvement Project

The Environmental Assessment for the Ketchikan Shipyards proposed improvements has been completed and is now available for public review. The Proposed Action includes: construction of ship repair, maintenance, assembly shops and structures, security, and waste management facilities. The proposed shipyard improvements would provide for a broad mix of new-build and repair work and enable the shipyard to meet the transportation needs of the publicly owned marine transit system.

The Federal Transit Administration (FTA) is currently evaluating the proposed alternatives. Your comments are important to us. Upon approval, the FTA will prepare a Finding of No Significant Impact for the Proposed Action detailing their conditions of approval.
