

NOTICE OF PROPOSED CHANGES IN THE
REGULATIONS OF DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION

BRIEF DESCRIPTION

The Department of Administration proposes to change a regulation on public information that affects the Alaska Industrial Development and Export Authority ("AIDEA"). The change is to update the regulation's reference to AIDEA's booklet named "Procedures for Inspection of Records" and to clarify that the public records regulations of 2AAC Chapter 96 apply to AIDEA to the extent consistent with AIDEA's booklet.

The Department of Administration proposes to adopt regulation changes in Title 2 of the Alaska Administrative Code, dealing with public records, including the following:

2 AAC 96.100(e) is proposed to be changed to update the reference in the regulation to the booklet of the Alaska Industrial Development and Export Authority entitled "Procedures for the Inspection of Records." The Authority's July 1, 1999 booklet has been superseded by a July 2012 booklet. The proposed amendment to 2 AAC 96.100(e) will adopt by reference the July 2012 "Procedures for Inspection of Records" booklet and state that the public records regulations of 2 AAC Chapter 96 apply to the Authority to the extent the regulations of 2 AAC Chapter 96 are consistent with the procedures of the July 2012 booklet.

You may comment on the proposed regulation changes, including the potential costs to private persons of complying with the proposed changes, by submitting written comments to the Department of Administration at P.O. The comments must be received no later than 5 p.m. on January 8, 2014.
