Signed into law by the Governor on June 19, 2006:

SB 188, sponsored by Sen. Donny Olson and Rep. Richard Foster, amended AEA's Bulk Fuel Loan Program to help rural communities cope with rising energy costs. The bill comes from recommendations made by the **Governor's Rural Energy Action Council**. The bill increases the loan amount from \$300,000 to \$400,000 for a single borrower. It also increases buying power for cooperative organizations representing more than one community from \$400,000 multiplied by the number of communities, or \$1.5 million, whichever is less.
