AIDEA Receives State Energy Financing Institution Designation by U.S. Department of Energy

April 8, 2024 (Anchorage, Alaska) – The Alaska Industrial Development and Export Authority (AIDEA) is proud to announce its designation as one of the first State Energy Financing Institutions (SEFI) by the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE).

Under the Title 17 Clean Energy and Domestic Supply Financing Program, the DOE's Loan Programs Office can finance a number of different projects including critical mineral projects. Projects that receive meaningful financial support or credit enhancements from a SEFI are exempt from Title 17's technological innovation requirement and may qualify for reduced matching funds. The SEFI designation is a significant achievement for AIDEA. It adds to the financing capabilities and reduces financial barriers for eligible Alaska projects.
