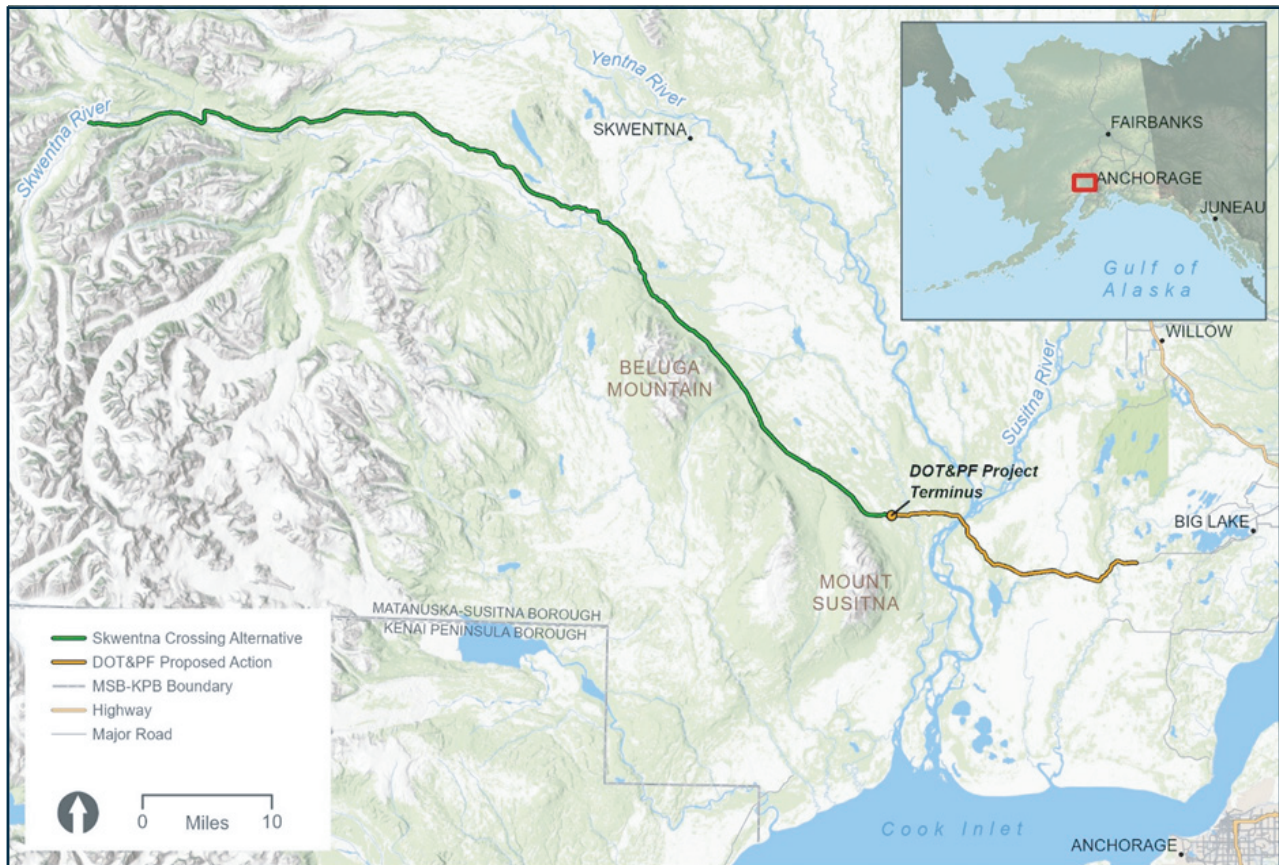


# West Susitna Access Project

The AIDEA West Susitna Access (WSA) Project will begin roughly 1.4 miles west of Alexander Creek at the endpoint of the Alaska Department of Transportation & Public Facilities (DOT&PF) West Susitna Access Road Project.

Below are some highlights of AIDEA's WSA road project:

- 78.5 mile public access road; ending at the Whiskey-Bravo mineral exploration camp/airstrip.
- Two-lane, gravel-surface, 24-foot wide road with similar limits and restrictions as other DOT& PF public roads.
- Four major bridges (3 on the Skwentna River and 1 on the Chickak River) and six smaller bridges.
- Providing safe, year-round access from the existing highway system to currently remote State lands for public-use activities such as fishing, hunting, boating, recreation, settlement, and to areas planned for resources development.
- Funding of the road will be similar to the successful AIDEA road and port project that provides access to the Red Dog Mine.
